### ***Why Join the AAP?***

#### **EDUCATIONAL CONFERENCE:**

Every Fall, we hold our annual educational conference. There are more than 350 attendees, over 70 vendors, and invaluable workshops provided by experts. You also have the opportunity to meet and network with other Assistant Principals, as well as AAP and CSA leaders. When you join the AAP the conference fee is waived the first year of membership. Certificates of Attendance are issued.

#### **ANNIVERSARY CERTIFICATES:**

At our annual educational conference, we recognize our members who have achieved their 5th, 10th, 15th or 20th plus anniversary date. A certificate of merit is presented to the Assistant Principals.

#### **PERSONAL AND PROFESSIONAL STAFF DEVELOPMENT:**

#### **GRADUATION CERTIFICATES:**

Every year, we send two beautiful *Certificates of Special Merit* to every elementary and middle school in the five boroughs to be presented at graduation.

#### **AAP GRANT:**

Every year, we offer three awards of up to \$1000 to each school as seed money to get programs started by Assistant Principals in their school.

#### **MARTIN SAFRAN AWARDS AND DINNER:**

At this annual dinner, we award each of the 15 students who give service to their school and/or their community a check for \$100, a plaque and other prizes. Invited as guest to this dinner in June are the student, his/her parent, and his/her AP who must be a member of AAP.

#### **STEWART WEINER SCHOLARSHIP:**

We offer (3) \$1000 scholarships to our members' children who are high school seniors and plan to enroll full time in a degree granting program at an accredited institution for the Fall semester. The scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis, depending upon academic performance, extracurricular involvement, civic achievement, school recommendations and the candidate's own personal statement.
